Description of Placement

Brunswick ward is a 24 bedded mixed General Adult Acute care Psychiatry ward.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Trainee

- Most of the trainee's work will be carried out at Broad Oak Unit, which has the inpatient unit facility.
- Core clinical work and responsibility is outlined below.
- The trainee will undertake clinical work at the Broadoak unit, Mossley Hill Hospital (old age wards), Rathbone Rehabilitation Hospital, STAR unit(LD wards) when on call.
- There will be an expectation that the trainee attends local postgraduate teaching programmes, as well as specific programmes that the deanery facilitates.

Core Clinical Work Include details of where this will be carried out, type of assessments and therapies for which the doctor in training will be responsible (all experience must be appropriate to the level of training provided)

- Management of patients admitted to the Park Unit under supervision of Consultant for the team.
- Attend and participate in ward reviews as timetabled
- Supervise, monitor and assist other junior doctor (FY2) in the day to day management of inpatients.
- Attend MDT meetings

- Dictate discharge summaries.
- To maintain up to date electronic and other medical records to a high standard.
- To attend 117 after care meetings.
- To see carers/relatives as required

- Be able to perform specialist assessment of patients and document relevant history and examination on culturally diverse patients- assessing patients under supervision and doing WPBAs, discuss in weekly supervision sessions

- Based on the full psychiatric assessment, demonstrate the ability to conduct therapeutic interviews; that is to collect and use clinically relevant material-WPBAs, linking in with the inpatient psychologist and observing psychological assessment.
- Demonstrate the ability to concisely, accurately and legibly record appropriate aspects of the clinical assessment and management plan- WPBAs for record keeping
- Management of severe and enduring mental illness- discussing the treatment plan with the consultant and completing the necessary WPBAs
- To develop the habits of lifelong learning by maintaining good medical practice- supervisor's report
- Develop the ability to conduct and complete audit in clinical practice- audit report, presenting in the local academic teaching, WPBA
- To develop an understanding of the implementation of clinical governancediscussion of clinical governance in the supervisions and evidence it in the supervisor's report
- Use effective communication with patients, relatives and colleagues- feedback from staff and patients; supervisor's report
- Demonstrate the ability to work effectively with colleagues, including team working- Mini Pat
- Develop appropriate leadership skills- doing quality improvement projects and audits
- Demonstrate the knowledge, skills and behaviours to manage time and problems effectively- feedback from staff and supervisor's report
