Description of Placement

The main facility is Moorside Unit which houses around 51 patients in a male ward, female ward and a mixed gender small psychiatric intensive care unit. They will be attached to the trainer's team, with an inpatient caseload of 24 - 26.

- Psychiatric reports for courts/solicitors re criminal cases, with opportunities for experience in attending court as an expert witness.
- Attendance at the mental health court diversion service in Manchester Magistrates and Crown Courts
- Mental Health Review Tribunal report writing and attendance.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Trainee

The caseload is both male and female patients.
