Description of Placement

CT in Adult Psychiatry, based at Moorside Unit, Trafford General hospital with responsibility for inpatient work. This is an inpatient General adult psychiatry post.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Trainee

- 1 Attending ward rounds which are on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.
- 2 Carrying out ward work i.e. Clinical investigations, Mental State Examination, physical examination and referral to different specialities
- 3 Weekly Outpatients Clinic x 1-2 under consultant's supervision
- 4 Weekly Educational Supervision
- 5 Participation in the ECT rota
- 6 On Call rota 1 in 10
